Magic Town Music Festival explodes with a VIP Kick-off Party, Friday, March 11th where guests will mingle with the festival musicians while enjoying delicacies from local restaurants and an open bar. Live performances from our musicians throughout the night will keep the party rocking with lots of surprises in the works! The price is \$100 USD per person and limited to 200 guests. The owners of Hacienda de los Picachos are proud to donate this year's venue for the Saturday and Sunday performances: an elegant, beautifully renovated events center at the base of the Picacho Mountains. They share our goal to raise awareness and as much funding as possible to support the mission of **Casa de los Ángeles**.

Casa de los Angeles, founded in 2000 as a safe haven for single moms, serves some of the San Miguel de Allende community's poorest children and their families. **Casa de los Ángeles** is currently providing daycare, medical services, food, emergency shelter, temporary housing, and educational grants to 100+ infants and toddlers in the San Miguel community. The success of the center lies in the palpable passion of its founder, **Donna Quatham**, and the dedicated people drawn by Donna's deep, abiding love for every family, mother, child, volunteer, and supporter. **Casa de los Ángeles** owes its continued existence and success to the support of a committed community; to date, over 1,800 volunteers from 34 countries have supported the organization in multiple roles.

In the spirit of community, the families are required to participate in the life of the daycare center by giving one hour of service for each day their child is present. **Casa de los Ángeles** provides services to about 100 children and, to date, has hosted approximately 1,500 children, feeding their bodies and minds and making sure there is a smile on every precious face.

Magic Town Music Festival is a community collaboration with an ALL-volunteer organizing committee both in Mexico and in the United States. The festival brings a unique, world-class music lineup to San Miguel de Allende and a quality and diversity of music "not often heard" in this part of the world! All net proceeds of the event are donated to Casa de los Ángeles.
